CATEGORIES

Solos, Duets/Trios, Small & Large Groups

- JAZZ
- TAP

- BALLET (includes classical and demi character)
- POINTE
- MUSICAL THEATRE (live voice w/ dancing, no mic , no background vocals)
- SONG AND DANCE (character piece w/dancing, lip synch)
- STUDENT CHOREOGRAPHY
- TEACHER FEATURE
- PRODUCTION

TIME LIMITS

- **SOLOS** – 2.5 minutes; Musical Theatre – 3 minutes
- **DUETS/TRIOS** – 3 minutes
- **SMALL GROUPS** – 4 minutes (4 – 9 dancers)
- **LARGE GROUPS** – 5 minutes (10 + dancers)
- **PRODUCTION** – minimum of 8 minutes, maximum of 15 minutes

SKILL LEVELS

- **BEGINNER** - less than 2 years of dance/competing in discipline
- **NOVICE** - 2 – 4 years of dance in discipline
- **INTERMEDIATE** - 5 – 7 years dance in discipline
- **SENIOR** - 8+ years dance in discipline

iPod hook-up will be provided and run by the studio director/instructor backstage.

ENTRY FEES

- **SOLOS** - \$25
- **DUETS/TRIOS** - \$20
- **GROUPS** - \$18
- **PRODUCTION** - \$18

Payment of all fees must be submitted no later than January 12, 2018.

Entries received by December 31, 2017 are eligible to receive a 5% discount on entry fees.

ENTRY

- ALL dances must have a name or title.
- Entries must be submitted by dance studios, not by individuals.
- Changes made, in writing only, can be submitted up until 2 weeks after the draft program is sent out.
- Entries submitted after January 12, 2018 will be subject to a 10% administration fee.

AWARDS AND ADJUDICATION

- Bronze: 79 and under
- Silver: 80-84
- Gold: 85-89
- Platinum: 90 and over
- Groups
 - Cash award for Outstanding Group, Most Promising Group and Outstanding Choreography for each session.
- Solos/Duets/Trios
 - Award and/or Cash Scholarship for Outstanding, Most Promising and Adjudicators Choice for Solo/Duet/Trio.
- One on one adjudications held on stage after each session.

GENERAL FESTIVAL INFORMATION

- Festival will be held each morning, afternoon and evening as entries permit.
- Each Festival class will be adjudicated by one judge.
- Awards will be cash or scholarships.
- Each entry will receive a mark and award standing.
- Each session there will be an award for Outstanding Performance, Most Promising and Adjudicator's Choice. The Group categories are Outstanding, Most Promising and Choreography Awards.
- Personal one on one adjudications will be given at the end of each session and will provide the dancers with the invaluable experience of instant feedback.
- It is **MANDATORY** that dancers are supervised backstage and in the dressing rooms at all times to ensure safety and sportsmanlike behaviour. Failure to do so may result in disqualification from the festival.
- Food will be available to purchase for competitors and spectators on location.
- Hotel rooms will be pre-booked at discounted rates, under the *Saskatchewan Express* name.
- More information on hotel rooms will be forwarded to you after we receive your registration.
